Congratulations to Cindy N. She was recognized as New Dimensions Employee of the Month for June, 2013.

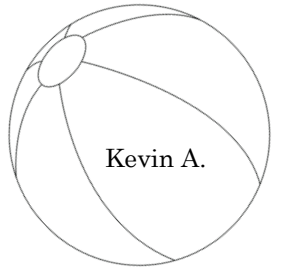
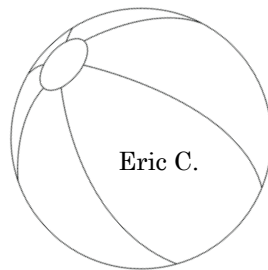
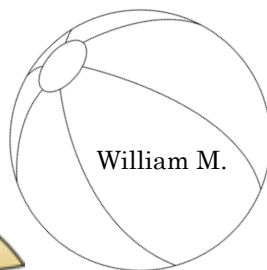
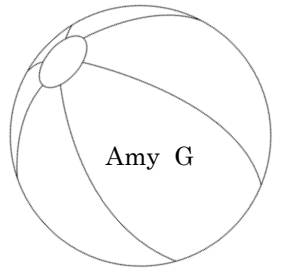
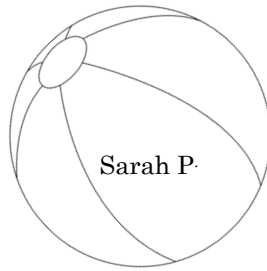
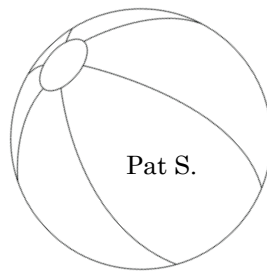

Instead of offering candy bars or chocolate pies at break and lunch, Food Service will offer celery with peanut butter, bananas, and other fresh fruits and vegetables.
